Overview

The HIRC Resiliency Badge Program Assessment drives two key outcomes for participating Suppliers:

- i) Differentiate yourself within the healthcare industry, demonstrating resilience across eight domains
- ii) Pinpoint opportunities for growth and resiliency development within your organizations

Supplier Scoping Guidelines for Badge Program Assessment

The following scoping guidelines can be leveraged by suppliers to maximize the ROI and impact of the Badge Program by identifying key products to evaluate, elevate & enhance resiliency.

Focus on key product families to highlight supply chain resilience and innovation

This may be based on any relevant criteria and thresholds as determined by the Supplier & Assessor, such as revenue, units sold, or criticality to healthcare outcomes.

Identify similar products that may be assessed with a single Badging Exercise

Operational Footprint

Sites, geographies, processes, product synthesis pathways

Governance

Policies, risk management

Categorization

Products sold under same umbrella family/product line

Measures

Similar drivers for KPI calculation/management

General rule of thumb: the assessment artifacts should be 85% same or similar across the products

- Products within the same business unit or service line may satisfy the above scoping guidelines
- Products across business units or service lines require compatibility for a single badging exercise
